This position is responsible for performing a variety of guest service and risk management functions such as incident handling, administering first aid, trail maintenance, promoting and creating a safe environment for guests and employees, Opening and Closing procedures, lift evacuation, search and rescue, and promoting and enforcing the skier's responsibility code. The job responsibilities of this position include, but are not limited to:

Duties and responsibilities:

- Provide guests with top quality guest service in a friendly and positive manner.
- Respond to sick and injured persons on trail and resort premises, stabilize and transport patients, and initiate and facilitate the transfer of patients to definitive care if necessary.
- Perform opening and closing duties related to trails, hazard marking, signage, and equipment checks
- Perform trail checks daily, including but not limited to, unmarked obstacles, downed rope closures, bamboo, fence lines, etc.
- Perform general on-mountain safety work daily, including but not limited to, maintaining tower pads, bamboo, rope, race closures, traffic control, etc.
- Transport injured skiers by sled, toboggan
- Transport awkward and/or heavy equipment while skiing or operating snowmobiles.
- Act as Mountain Dispatch
- Take a teamwork-oriented approach to interactions within the patrol and between departments.
